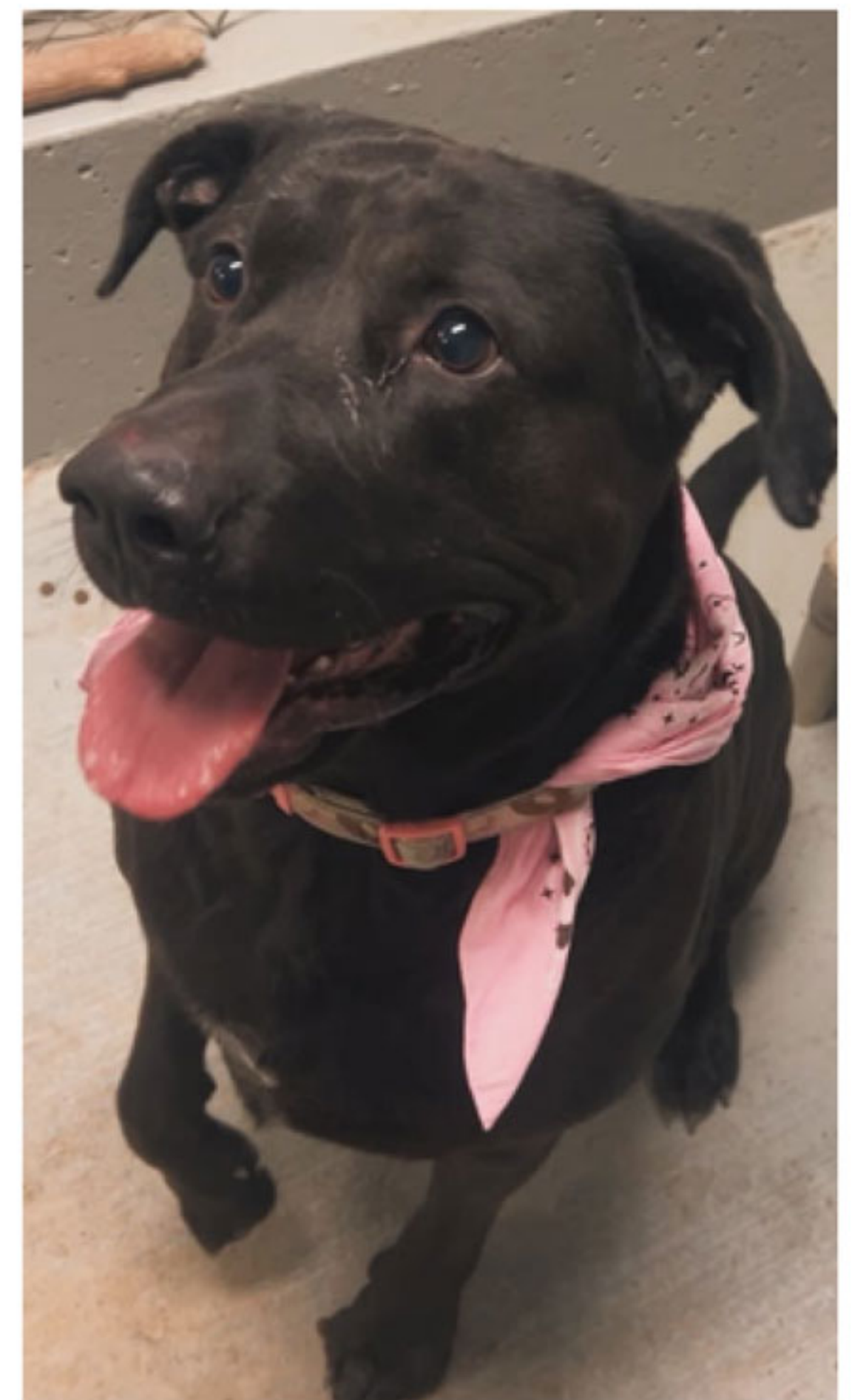

Rescue stories come in countless forms, but one of the most heartwarming features a stray Great Pyrenees named Waco. Discovered malnourished and wandering in a family's yard with no collar or microchip, she was taken in for food and vet care. Days later, she gave birth to eight puppies, turning a single rescue into a joyful family of nine. Because rescue stories happen every day, it's common to deal with dogs that have varying degrees of trauma, from separation anxiety to fear of shelters. For example, the community on the Reddit r/rescuedogs forum generally agrees that many behavioral issues in rescues stem directly from survival instincts developed while living on the streets.

Today, the demographic has expanded far beyond traditional retirees. Solo travelers and remote workers now utilize off-grid power systems, Starlink, and apps to live and work from beaches, Bureau of Land Management (BLM) public lands, and forest service roads.

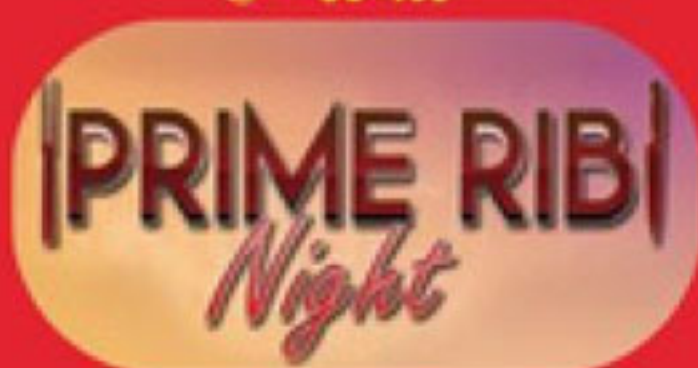

The Kootenai Falls Swinging Bridge is a 210-foot suspension bridge hanging 100 feet above the Kootenai River. Located off US Highway 2 between Troy and Libby, the iconic landmark was originally built in 1937 by the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) to help firefighters access remote timberlands.

The original wooden structure was destroyed in a massive flood in 1948. Three years later, in 1951, a rebuilt suspension bridge was erected atop concrete piers. Over the decades, the bridge required routine rehabilitation as its popularity grew—due in part to being a featured filming location in movies like *The Revenant*. Because the crossing could only support a limited number of people at a time and was aging, the U.S. Forest Service replaced it with an updated, sturdier, and slightly wider suspension bridge in late July 2019. Today, you can access this thrilling landmark via a scenic, half-mile hiking trail starting at the Kootenai Falls parking area near Milepost 21.
